

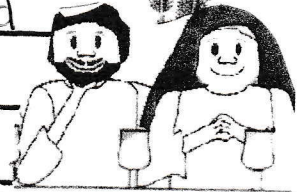
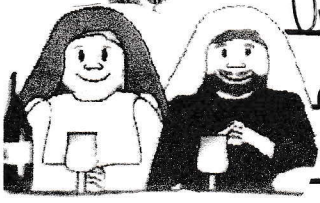


Palm Sunday

On Palm Sunday now palm is blessed and we bring some home. At Mass we hear the story of Jesus' death.

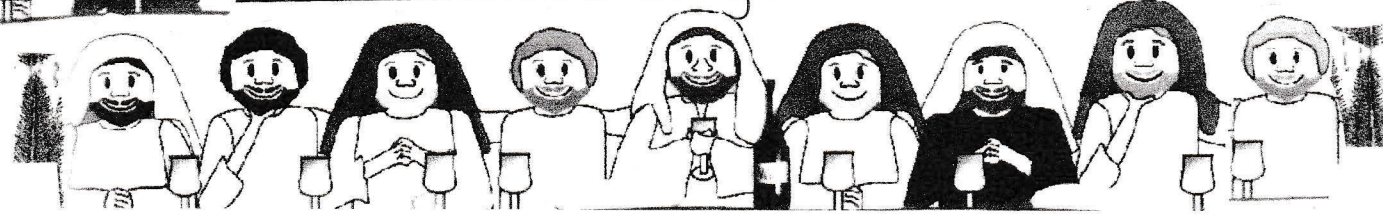
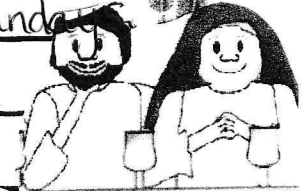


Holy Thursday.

We will share the bread of life at our First Holy Communion.

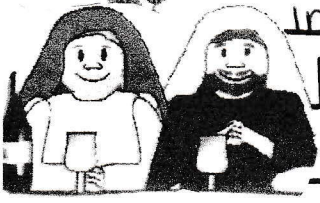




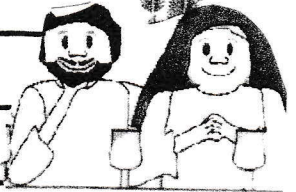
Good Friday.

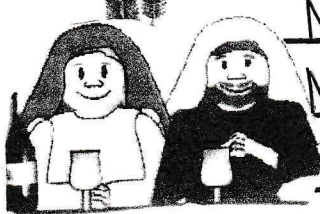
Now on Good Friday we kiss the cross and listen to the Passion.
